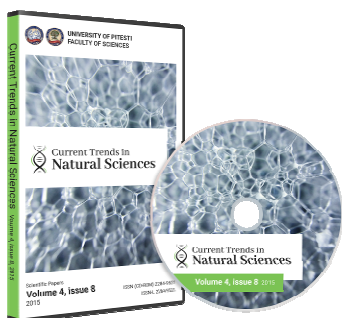
Preliminary program
